2010 Agricultural Education Scholarship Application

Our scholarship program is established to provide educational financial assistance to eligible member-owners and the children of Foremost Farms USA® member-owners. This program is sponsored and funded by the Foremost Farms USA Charitable Foundation.

This scholarship program is administered by Scholarship Management Services, a division of Scholarship America. Scholarship Management Services is the nation's largest designer and manager of scholarship and tuition reimbursement programs for corporations, foundations, associations and individuals. Awards are granted without regard to race, color, creed, religion, sexual orientation, gender or disability.

Eligibility

To be eligible, the applicant must be:

- Any current high school/college student who meets all of the following qualifications is eligible to apply for one of Foremost Farms' \$2,000 agricultural scholarships.
- Applicant must be the son or daughter of a current Foremost Farms member or a member of Foremost Farms selling milk at the time of submitting the scholarship application and when cash awards are made. If a member-owner exits the cooperative the award will be forfeited.
- Applicant must have a sincere interest in continuing education in an agriculture-oriented occupational field.

- Applicant must plan to enroll or be enrolled full-time in an undergraduate course of study at an accredited university, college or vocational-technical institute for a degree program or short course program.

Awards

Up to ten awards of \$2,000 each will be granted this year. Awards are not renewable. Students are eligible to receive the award one time only. Awards are for undergraduate study only.

Application

Interested students must complete the attached application and mail it along with a current, complete transcript of grades to Scholarship Management Services **postmarked no later than February 26, 2010**. Grade reports are not acceptable. On-line transcripts must display student name, school name, grade and credit hours earned for each course, and term in which each course was taken. A letter of recommendation is also required.

Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied. Therefore, it is important to answer all questions as completely as possible. All information received is considered confidential and is reviewed only by Scholarship Management Services.

Selection

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, potential to succeed, involvement in dairy farm operations, leadership and participation in school and community activities, honors, work experience, statement of educational and career goals and an outside appraisal.

Selection of recipients is made by Scholarship Management Services. No employee of Foremost Farms USA will see any of the application materials or participate in the selection of the award recipients. All information is considered confidential.

Scholarship Payments

Foremost Farms USA will award up to ten \$2,000 scholarships to high school seniors graduating in 2010 and current college students.

Payment will be made after Scholarship Management Services receives a first quarter grade report. Checks are mailed to each recipient's home address and made payable to the school for the student. Students are eligible to receive only one scholarship.

Award Presentations

Applications must be postmarked on or before February 26, 2010, to be eligible for a 2010 Foremost Farms USA scholarship. After applications are reviewed and selections made, all applicants will be notified by mail in April 2010. Presentations to all winners will be arranged between the student, the school and Foremost Farms USA's communications specialist.

Obligations

A recipient has no obligation to Foremost Farms USA, but is required to supply Scholarship Management Services with complete transcripts when requested and to notify Scholarship Management Services of any changes of address, school enrollment or other relevant information. Except as described in this brochure, no obligation is assumed by Foremost Farms USA.
